The information in this booklet will explain the reading and spelling teaching that your child receives daily at school during KS2.

It also provides information on how you can help to support your child's daily reading and spelling development at home.

If you need clarification or would like to know more about our reading or spelling teaching, please make an appointment to speak to either Miss Goodall or your child's class teacher.

Your child is required to read for 20 minutes every day, and should also practise the spellings in their Log book daily. Once your child has read each day, they should write about what they have read in their reading diary.

This reading poster will assist you when you are reading with your child and asking them questions.

Becoming Better Readers...

Questions you can ask your child about their book.

★ Who is the main character?

★ Where is the story set?



★ What was the problem in the story and how was it solved?

★ What do you think will happen next in your story?

★ Which character do you like most? Why?

★ Which character do you think would make a good friend? Why?

★ What was your favourite part of the story?

★ Did you like the ending? Why/why not?
