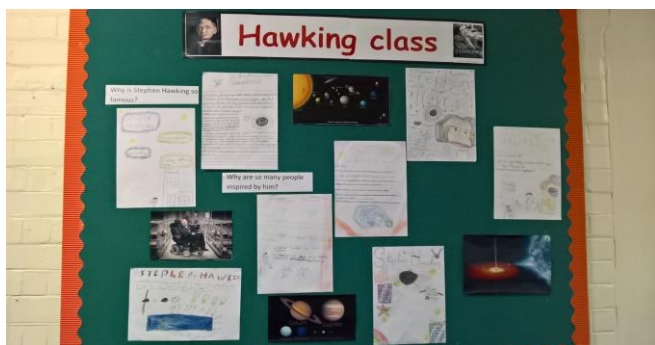




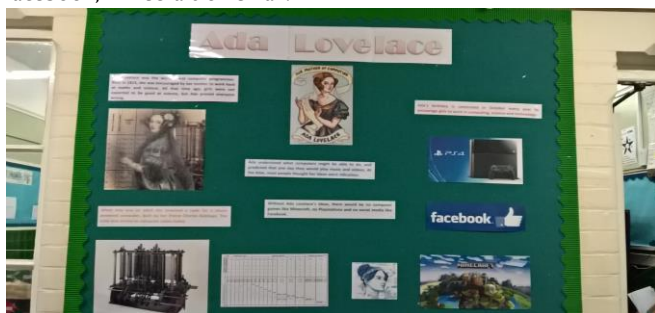
From Mrs Silke
