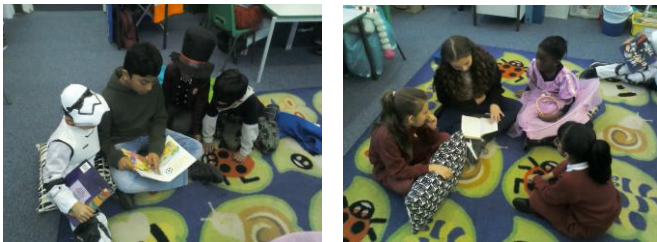


From Mrs Silke
