



Parent FAQs- Remote Learning

1. How will remote learning work?

Remote learning will be slightly different for Early Years/KS1 and KS2. Please see below for further details.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning will be uploaded onto SeeSaw • Each session will have a parent guidance slide which will help you support your child with their learning • Audio will be included on these sessions from the class teachers so that pupils can get further information on the learning (and hear their class teachers voice!) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learning will be uploaded onto SeeSaw • Core sessions (Reading, Writing and Maths) will have live teacher input via Teams. • This will be followed up by small 'seminar groups' to further support individual pupils. • The wider curriculum will be uploaded to SeeSaw with accompanying audio to support learning further.

2. What are the pupils going to be doing between Wednesday 6th- Friday 8th January?

On the first three days, pupils will use the Oak National Academy resources- this is so that we can ensure ALL pupils have access to devices and log-ins before beginning the above plan on Monday 11th January. (The only exception to this is Y6 who are already set up and ready to go because their bubble previously burst!) This is an example of the document you will receive by email (check your junk email)- click directly into the links and it'll take you to the Oak resources- no log in is required for this.

4. What log-ins do I need? Where can I get these from?

R-2 need SeeSaw Log-ins, Purple Mash, Charanga

Y3-6 need See Saw, email address (gives access to Teams), Mathletics, Time Table Rockstars, Charanga, Purple Mash

All of these logins will be given out in today's check-ins calls with the teachers if you did not receive a copy of these.

5. YEAR 3-6 ONLY- How do I log into Teams?

The TEAMS app can be downloaded, and you use your child's email address and password to log in. The video below will help!

6. Are there going to be 'live' lessons?

Live lessons will be for Y3-Y6 in the core subject. Teachers will provide teacher input live via Teams and then do smaller group teaching. All other subject material will be hosted on SeeSaw with accompanying audio/video.

7. What is the timetable for the day? What time do pupils need to 'log in'?

The whole class on-site/off-site will be running on the same timetable. See below for timetable. From Monday 11th January pupils learning remotely will need to follow the below timetable. REMEMBER- The first three days of learning can be accessed via document that's been emailed to you and contains hyperlinks for Oak National Academy.
